# **Review of Project Status**

#### 2012 Bond

Rebecca Kelley presented the 2012 Bond Project summary sheet updated though November 30, 2018 and indicated that as of November 30, 2018, \$37,761,480 or 93.7% of the bond funds have been obligated for purchase. The following were noted contributors to the increase:

- Safety & Security: Fencing, Cameras and Radios
- Various Painting Projects
- Band & Orchestra Instrument Replacement Cycle
- Student/Staff Computer Refresh

#### 2014 Bond

Alec Journey presented a construction update for the 2014 bond projects. He indicated that as November 30, 2018 \$97,770,114 or 55.87% of the bond funds have been obligated for purchase.

  - New Lanier Gymnasium
  - Polk & Griffith Classroom additions and Gymnasium
  - Package A projects from Summer 2016
  - Package B & CTE projects from Summer 2017
  - New Beutel Elementary
  - Package C Projects from Summer 2018

  - New Freeport Elementary
- Projects still in construction phase are:
  - Ogg Elementary is on schedule (pictures presented)
  - > Press box improvements at Slade Field
  - Roberts Elementary Replacement (pictures presented)
- Brannen Elementary Replacement is in the Bid Phase (transportation map presented)

### 2019 Bond Planning Update

Rebecca Kelley presented an update on the work from the Long Range Facilities/Bond Planning Committee. In August 2018, the BISD Board of Trustees approved the establishment of the committee and charged them as follows: the next step for the future of Brazosport ISD is to research and prioritize educational opportunities and facility needs to ensure optimal learning experiences for all students. The committee met 5 times and went on a tour of campuses and facilities. Meeting agenda included:

- School Finance
- > Career & Technology Programming Opportunities
- Demographic Projections
- > Full Day Pre-Kindergarten
- Facility Assessment Overview
- Facility Priorities and Proposed Projects
- > Financial Adviser for Bond Capacity
- Bond Package Priority Consensus

Ms. Kelley also presented the District Facilities Master Plan with a scope of work that the Long Range/Bond Planning Committee will recommend to the BISD Board of Trustees in January. The recommendation will call an order for a bond election for \$267 million. The 2019 package for \$267 million includes expanding the scope of several projects included in the 2014 bond program. For example, there was \$13.5 million allocated for Bwood Auditorium upgrades, interior finishes, exterior improvements, library/media, mechanical, engineering and plumbing upgrades. Now that the 2019 bond package will include a new Brazoswood main campus, fine arts, CTE, and field house replacement, it becomes fiscally responsible to utilize those funds from 2014 for upgrades towards the 2019 replacement. A complete list of proposed projects and corresponding 2014 available funds were presented.

### Reallocation of Project Funds - 2012 Bond

Rebecca Kelley proposed a total reallocation of \$1,088,441 to cover the following projects highlighted in vellow:

## Reallocation of Project Funds – 2014 Bond

Rebecca Kelley proposed that \$24,297,000 from 2014 be reserved and carried over if voters pass the recommendation for a \$267,000,000 bond on May 5, 2019. Below is a summary of funding by campus and project scope:
